Procedure

The New Zealand Journal of Occupational Therapy's (NZJOT) policy on copyright and archiving is in keeping with international publication standards. That is, authors have the right to:

- Circulate or post on any repository or website the version of the article that was submitted to the journal (i.e. the version before peer-review) – **'version 1'**.
- Post on any non-commercial repository or website the version of their article that was accepted for publication, **'version 2'**. The article may not be made available earlier than 12 months after publication in the Journal issue and may not incorporate the changes made by the editor after acceptance.
- Post the accepted version of the article, 'version 2' on their institutional website.
- Use the published version of the article, version 3 for their own teaching needs or to supply on an individual basis to research colleagues, provided that such supply is not for commercial purposes.

All commercial or any other re-use of the published article should be referred to New Zealand Journal of Occupational Therapy.
